Key Term	Definition
Sacrament	A visible sign and instrument of salvation in Jesus Christ
Catholic letters	New Testament letters directed to a universal audience
Letter of James	Catholic letter that is an important basis for Catholic social teaching
First Letter of Peter	Catholic letter that gives the New Testament's clearest teaching on suffering
Antichrist	A term used in the letters of John to describe an opponent of Christ
Book of Revelation	The last book in the entire Bible
Apocalypse	A word that means "revelation" or "unveiling"
Characteristics of apocalyptic writing	Symbolic language, heavenly visions, and an emphasis on God's eternal triumph
The number 6	Symbolically associated with imperfection
Docetism	Heretical teaching that Jesus only appeared to be human
Ecumenical Council	Worldwide, official assembly under the pope's authority
Church Fathers	Influential bishops and theologians active in the second through eighth centuries
Theotokos	Title given to Mary at the Council of Ephesus
Sacraments and Scripture	Ways Jesus is present in the Church
Eucharist	A word that means "thanksgiving"
Eucharist and Reconciliation	Sacraments that can be received as often as we want
