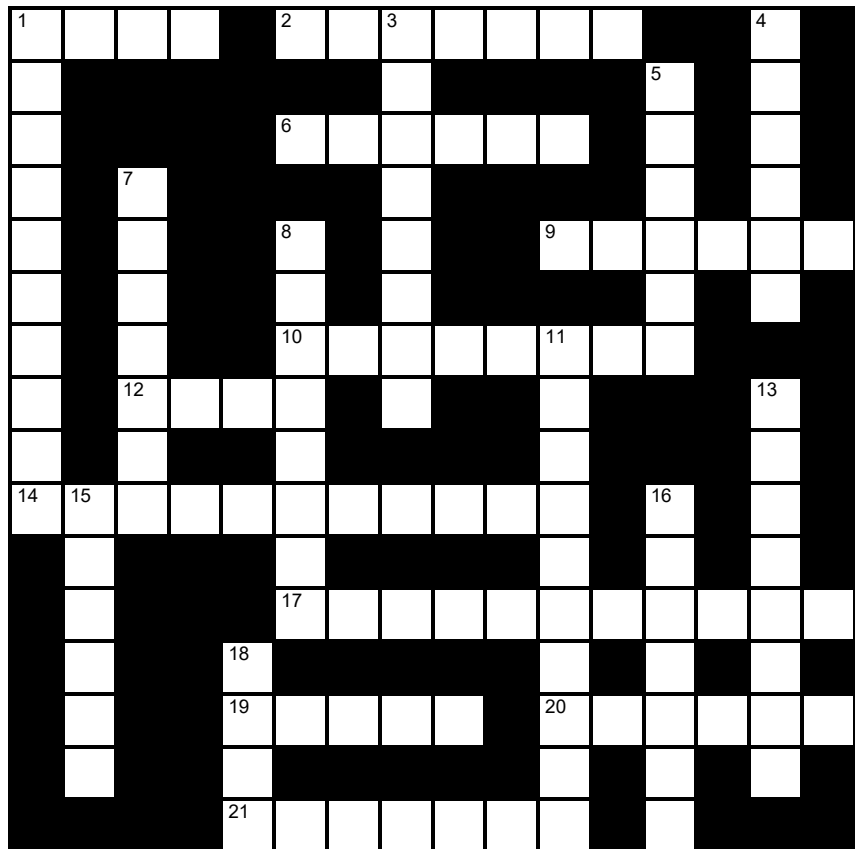


**Chapter 2 The Old Testament Our Call to Faith and Justice**
