2 A Church writer of great learning and holiness whose works the Church has highly recommended for studying and living the faith is given the title ____ of the Church. (6)

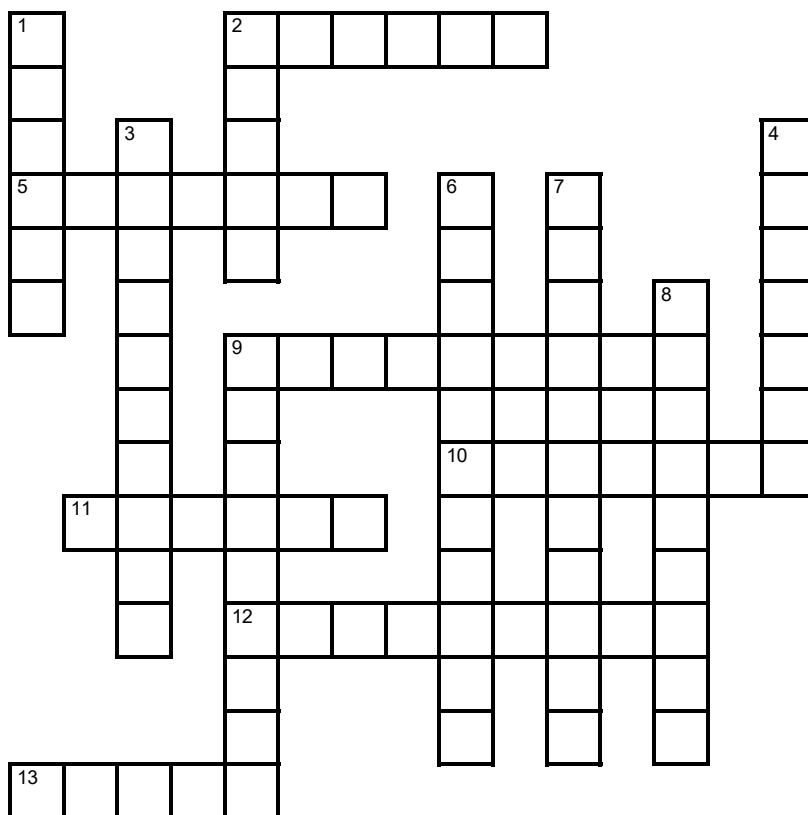

1 ____ literature is a collection of wise sayings, proverbs, and short stories that offer insights into the proper way to live. (6)

2 One who believes in God based only on natural reason, not on any specific Divine Revelation or teachings of a religion. (5)

3 Private revelation or personal message of something spiritual (10)

4 Christ's work of redemption,

accomplished principally by his Passion, Death, Resurrection, and glorious Ascension. This mystery is commemorated and made present in the sacraments, especially the Eucharist. (7)

- 6 The assuming of a human nature by Jesus Christ, God's eternal Son, who became man in order to save humankind from sin. The term literally means "being made flesh." (11)
- 7 The official teaching authority of the Church. Christ bestowed the right and power to teach in his name on St. Peter and the Apostles and their successors. It is the bishops in communion with the successor of Peter, the bishop of Rome (the pope). (11)
- 8 Refers to the belief that the Bible is infallible or without error. (9)
- 9 Sacred ____ is the speech of God as it is put down in writing under the breath of the Holy Spirit. (9)
