Consequences

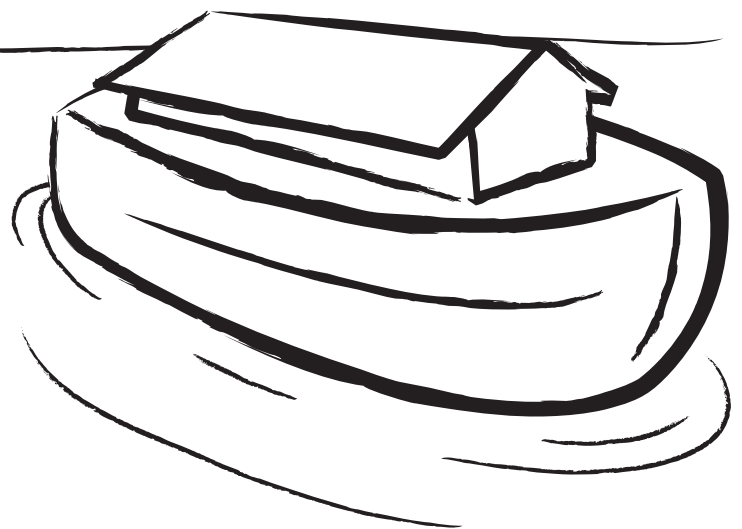
- Alienation from God
