- St. John Paul II (1978-2005)
- Benedict XVI (2005-2013)
- Francis (2013-2025)
- Leo XIV (2025-)

Assign the students to do further research on one of these popes in order to answer each of the questions on the Pope Research worksheet.

3. What is his time as pope most known for?
4. What do you find most interesting about this pope?

7. How has reading about this pope impacted your understanding of the papacy?
