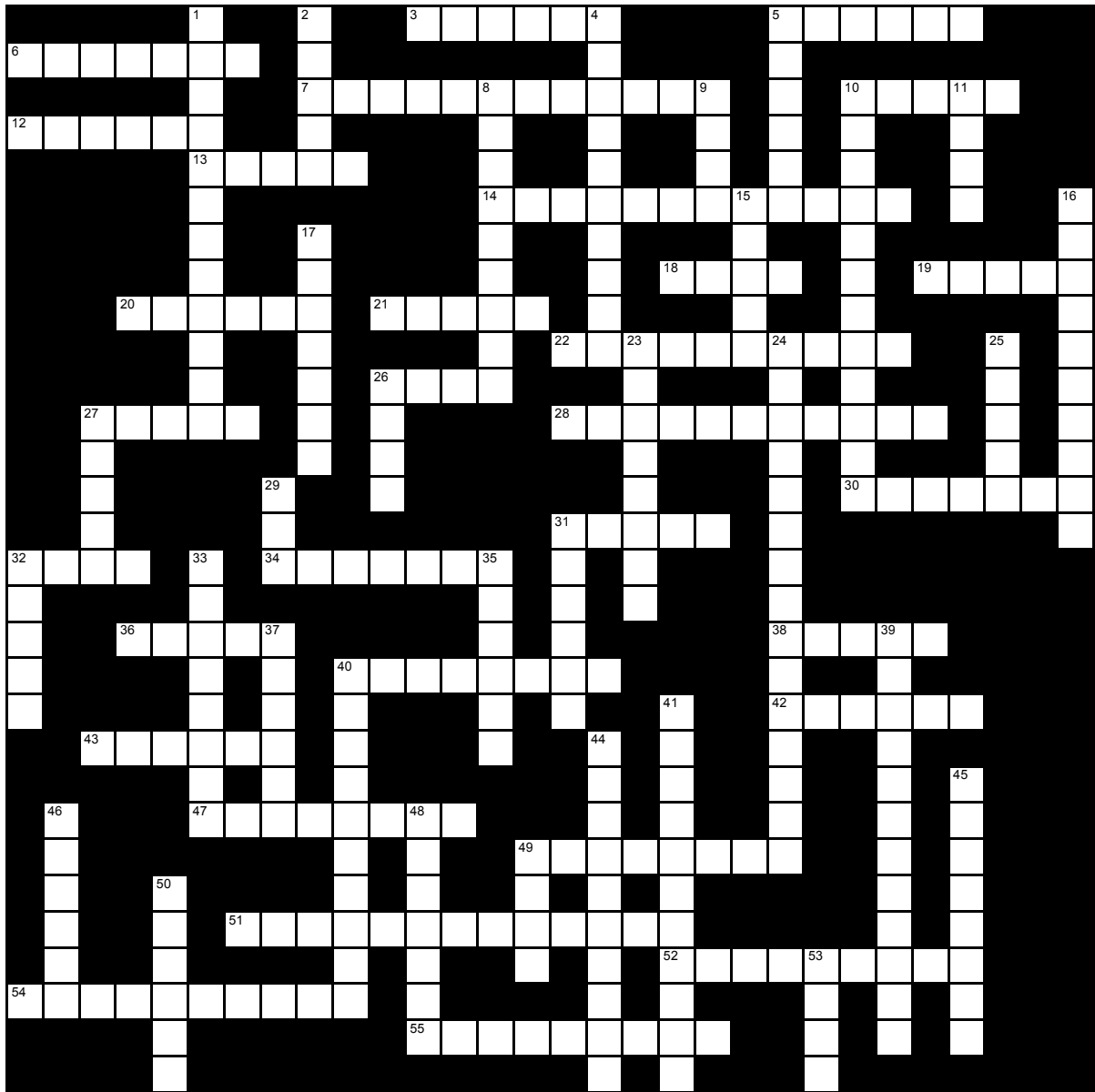

**39** A form of prayer that involves expressing gratitude to God for all that he gives to and for us (12)

**40** St. Therese of Lisieux belong to this religious order which was devoted to prayer (10)

**44** A form of prayer in which we ask God to forgive our sins (10)

**45** At the Last Supper, Jesus prayed his great \_\_\_\_\_ prayer of intercession to the Father (8)
