Jesus Christ is a historical figure who walked the earth at a particular point in history. The unique story of this particular historical figure is that he was both God and man. While the nature of his divinity can be traced to the one source which is the Holy Spirit, his human nature has a human source which is Mary.

As a human, Jesus has not only his mother as the source of his humanity, but can in fact trace his familial line back to Abraham, the father of the Jewish faith (see Mt 1:1-17)) and to the beginning with our common ancestor Adam and Eve (see Lk 3:23-38).

Your task is to fill in the missing ancestors in the family using the names in the word bank. Each name will be used only once. You may reference your Bible to help you with this assignment.
