

- 1. Prophet who introduced the idea of the resurrection from the dead for those who merited it
- **3.** Greek name for the geographic area of the Jews of the New Testament

- **6.** The writings of the Essene community at Qumran left us the scrolls
- 7. Celebrated the rededication of the Temple after it had been profaned
- **8.** Roman prefect who ruled figures prominently in the gospel accounts
- **9.** Generally had a low position in first-century Palestine with few political rights
- **12.** Herod who ruled Perea and Galilee during Jesus' lifetime
- 15. Converts to Judaism
- **16.** The Maccabean family led a revolt against the Greeks for placing a statue of this god in the Temple
- **18.** The language that Jesus spoke
- **19.** Gentiles who accepted Jewish beliefs but did not undergo circumcision
- **23.** Also known as the Feast of Booths, it was a fall harvest celebration
- **25.** The first two letters of the Greek word for Christ
- **27.** Another word for the Roman procurator who was directly answerable to the Roman governor in Syria
- **29.** Most Jews hated anyone who worked for the Romans collecting these
- **30.** Place where the Pharisees met to form a canon of sacred books
- **33.** They were mostly priests and aristocrats who cared for Temple practices and worship

- **34.** The nations of people who were not circumcised
- **37.** The destruction of the Temple took place under this Roman general in A.D. 70
- **39.** This is God's revelation of himself which literally means instruction
