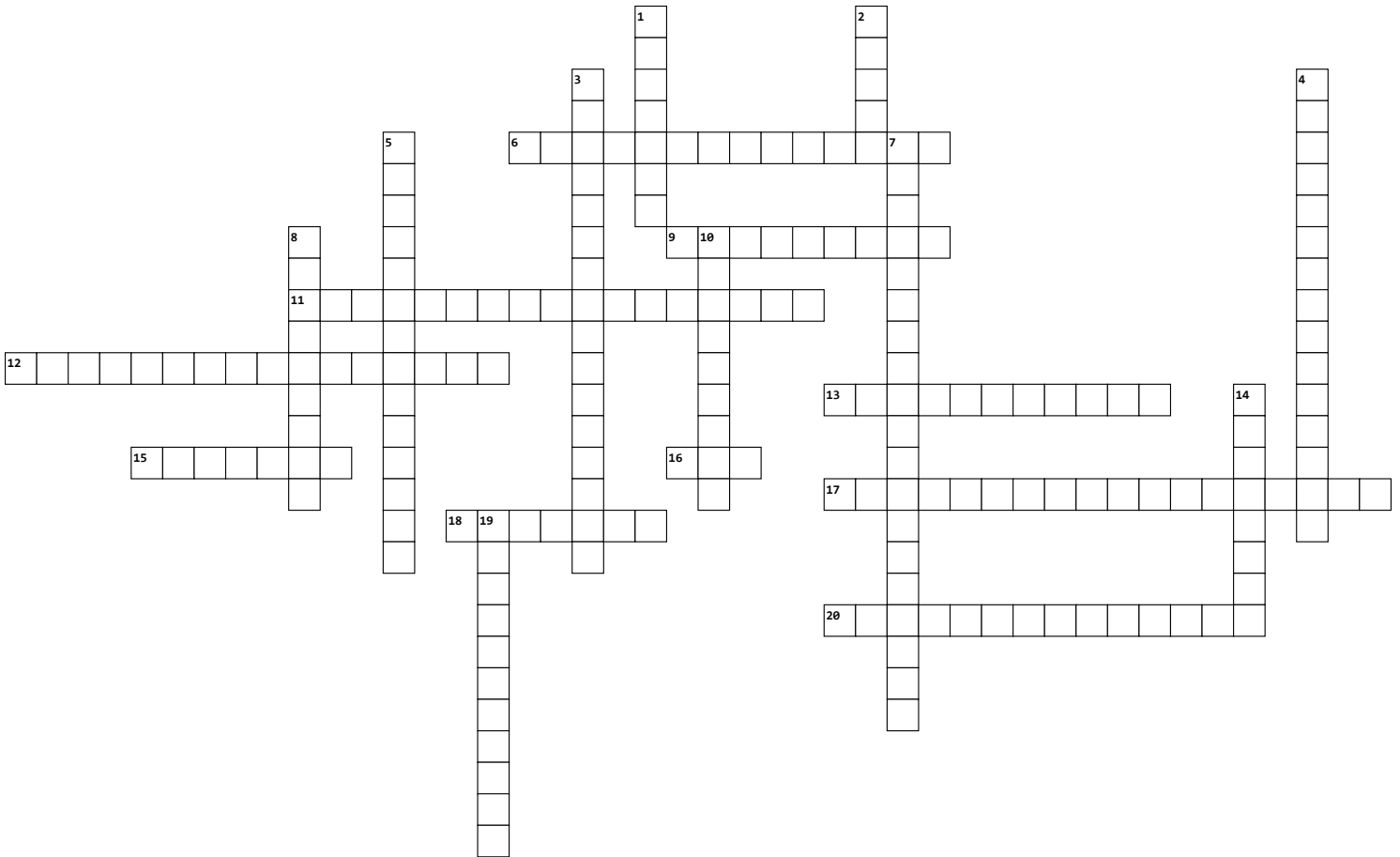


Seven Sacraments Chapter 1 Crossword Puzzle
