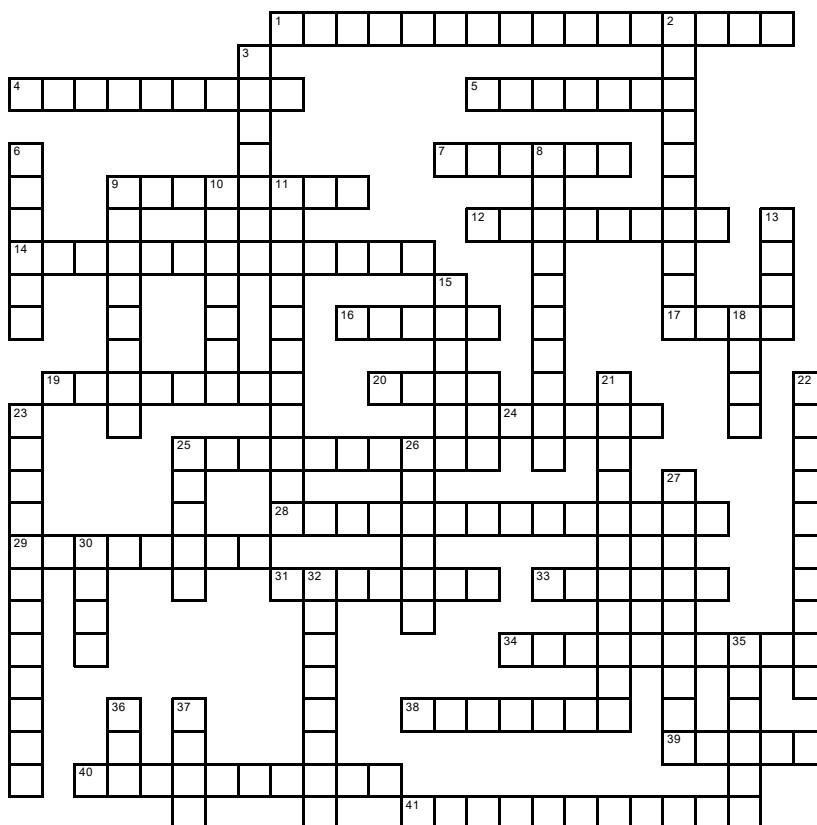

- 1 Refers to instances in the Bible when God is described using human characteristics. (16)
- 4 New \_\_\_\_ is a symbol of the Church that is present both in heaven and on earth through the Communion of Saints. (9)
- 5 \_\_\_\_ of most religions throughout the region also served as local banks. (7)
- 7 A brief, poetic declaration following a formula that establishes it as a message from God. (6)
- 9 The central focus of the Old Testament is the \_\_\_\_ theme of God's love for the Jewish people. (8)
- 12 A Greek word for "presence." It refers to the Second Coming of Christ, which will usher in the presence of God's Kingdom on earth as it is in heaven. (8)
- 14 A source probably written by priests of the northern kingdom who placed a great emphasis on morality. This source portrays Israel's history as a cycle of reward for faithfulness. (13)
- 16 In Hebrew Scriptures, the Pentateuch is called the \_\_\_\_\_. (5)



- 17 Paul names \_\_\_\_ as the greatest of the theological virtues. (4)
- 19 A source that contains census lists, genealogies, numbers, dates, descriptions of proper ways to worship, and the proper use of clean and unclean animals. (8)
- 20 The Canaanite god of fertility, associated with storms and rain. He was the most prominent of the Canaanite gods and the one most often worshipped falsely by the Israelites. (4)
- 24 The New Testament is essential because \_\_\_\_ is the New Testament- that is, God's New Covenant with all humanity. (5)
- 25 A privilege that included a ceremonial blessing given by the father. It had several benefits for the firstborn son. (10)
- 28 Refers to the study of Jesus Christ; the academic effort to understand who he is. (14)
- 29 A group migration or flight

away from the homeland into one or more other countries. The word can also refer to people who have maintained their separate identity while living in those countries after their migration. (8)

- 31 The Letter to the \_\_\_\_ is a written homily that develops the theme of Christ as High Priest, the model of faith. The author is anonymous. (7)
- 33 The love that we have for a friend or family member. (6)
- 34 The last book of the Bible, the Book of \_\_\_\_, speaks to the Christians about the persecutions using the highly symbolic apocalyptic style of writing in which the author, John of Patmos, was able to disguise the inspired message he intended to share. (10)
- 38 A source for the Pentateuch that can be recognized by its use of YHWH for God. (7)
- 39 Unconditional, selfless love. (5)
- 40 The Hebrew Scriptures have \_\_\_\_ books. (10)
- 41 The \_\_\_\_ virtues are the three important virtues bestowed on us at Baptism that relate us to God: faith, hope, and charity. (11)

- 2 The \_\_\_\_ books narrate the events of salvation history and the formation of Israel as the Chosen People. (10)

- 10 A source for the Pentateuch that is identified by its use of *Elohim*, a majestic term for God. (7)
- 11 From a word meaning "revelation" or "unveiling," these writings were usually written in time of crisis and used symbolic language to bolster faith by reassuring believers that the current age, subject to the forces of evil, will end when God intervenes and establishes a divine rule of goodness and peace. (11)
- 13 The earliest collection of laws is the Covenant \_\_\_\_, contained in the Book of Exodus. (4)
- 15 An acronym for Hebrew Scriptures taken from the first letter of the three main parts: Torah (Law), Nebi'im (Prophets), and Kethubim (Writings). (6)
- 18 The image of the \_\_\_\_ gives us clue as to how we remain attached to Jesus and the Church. (4)
- 21 The New Testament writers, though valuing God's Revelation in the Old Testament, believed Jesus to be the \_\_\_\_ of that Revelation.

- 22 An attribute of God that he is everywhere, unlimited, and all-powerful. (10)
- 23 A work written under a name that is not the name of the person doing the actual writing. (12)
- 25 The Old Covenant had been sealed with the \_\_\_\_ of an animal, while the New Covenant is sealed by the \_\_\_\_ of Christ. (5)
- 26 The Old English word for "good news." (6)
- 27 A prayer for Christ to come in glory at the end of time. (9)
- 30 \_\_\_\_, also authored by Luke and in many ways a second part of his Gospel, tells the story of the early Church and the work of the Apostles. (4)
- 32 The final age and the end of human history, including the Last Judgment, the defeat of evil, and the creation of a new heaven and earth. (8)
- 35 Jacob's new name that is related to the Hebrew verb *sara* ("struggle") and the first syllable of *Elohim* ("God"). (6)
- 36 Prior to reforms of the liturgy after the Second Vatican Council, a \_\_\_\_ Mass was the name to differentiate it from a High Mass. In a \_\_\_\_ Mass, the priest spoke rather than chanted the prayers that were assigned to him. (3)
- 37 Israel became like many of its neighboring nations by appointing a \_\_\_\_ to rule over them. (4)
