

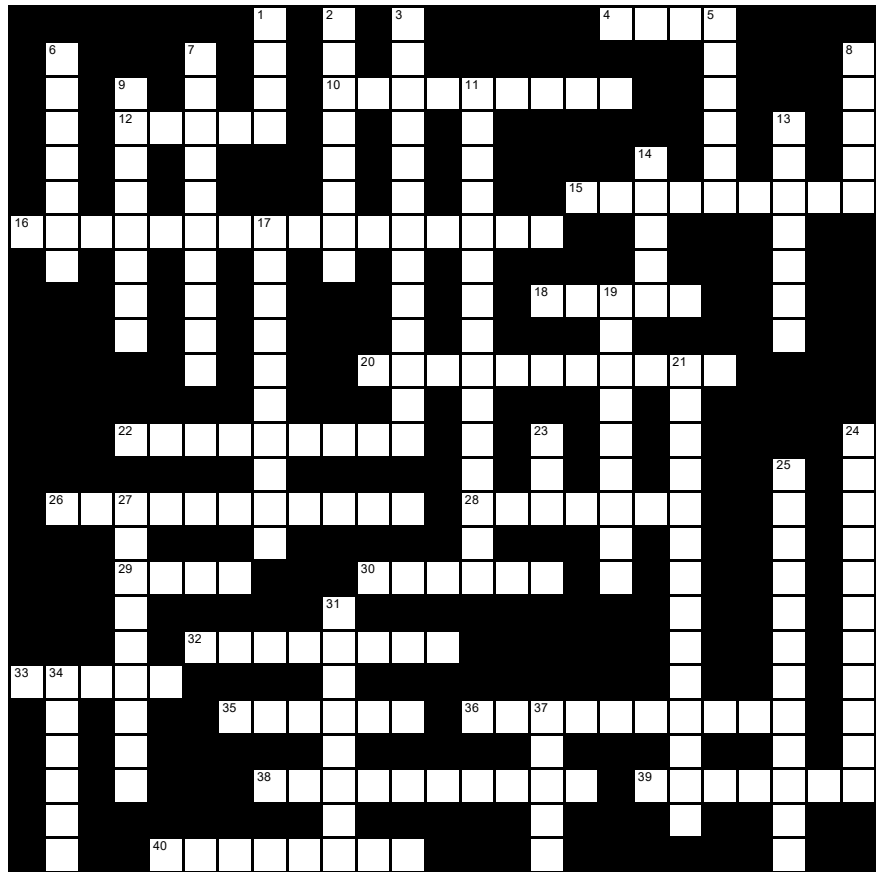

- 30 A group of non-Egyptians who came to power in Egypt roughly between 1650 and 1550 BC (6)
- 32 "Every time \_\_\_\_\_ is celebrated, the Exodus events are made present to the memory of believers so that they may conform their lives to them" (8)
- 33 Laws dealing with the day-to-day issues that arise between people living in community (5)
- 35 Mature, usually male, members of the Israelite community who met regularly to rule on specific disputes within the community (6)
- 36 Mercy killing of the aged or sick (10)
- 38 Jesus embraces the spirit of justice and community of the Mosaic Law in the \_\_\_\_\_ preached in the Sermon on the Mount (10)
- 39 Denial of God's existence (7)
- 40 The divinization of a creature in place of God (8)

- 1 The traditional name for God (4)
- 2 Having more than one spouse (8)
- 3 Also called the "Holiness Code," it is found in Leviticus 17—26 and is called such because it includes several uses



- the word "holy" (9,4)
- 5 The miraculous release of the Israelites from Egypt and their journey across the Red Sea to Mount Sinai (6)
- 6 Every seventh Sabbatical year; comes from the Hebrew word for "ram's horn" (7)
- 7 The stories in the Book of Exodus of the complaints of the Israelites in the desert against Moses and against God (10)
- 8 Literally means "drew out" (5)
- 9 The killing of an unborn baby (8)
- 11 The basic moral laws given by God to his people (3,12)
- 13 The sacrament that restores relationship between a sinner, God, and the Church (7)
- 14 Means "to desire something that is not one's own" (5)
- 17 The participation of man in God's eternal law that reveals what God intends us to do and avoid according to his wise and loving plan (7,3)
- 19 A sin that involves hateful words against God, Jesus, or the Church (9)
- 21 Sexual activity between persons of the same gender (10,4)
- 23 God reveals his name as "\_\_\_\_\_" meaning that he is the God who is always there (1,2)
- 24 Saying no one knows for sure whether God exists (11)
- 25 The deliberate stimulation of one's genital organs to derive sexual pleasure (12)
- 27 In the case of the Israelites, these laws governed the actions of the priests, the regulations for sacrifice, and the building and maintenance of the Temple (9)
- 31 An agreement between God and people (8)
- 34 Having sexual relations with relatives (6)
- 37 Taking of another's property against his or her will (5)
