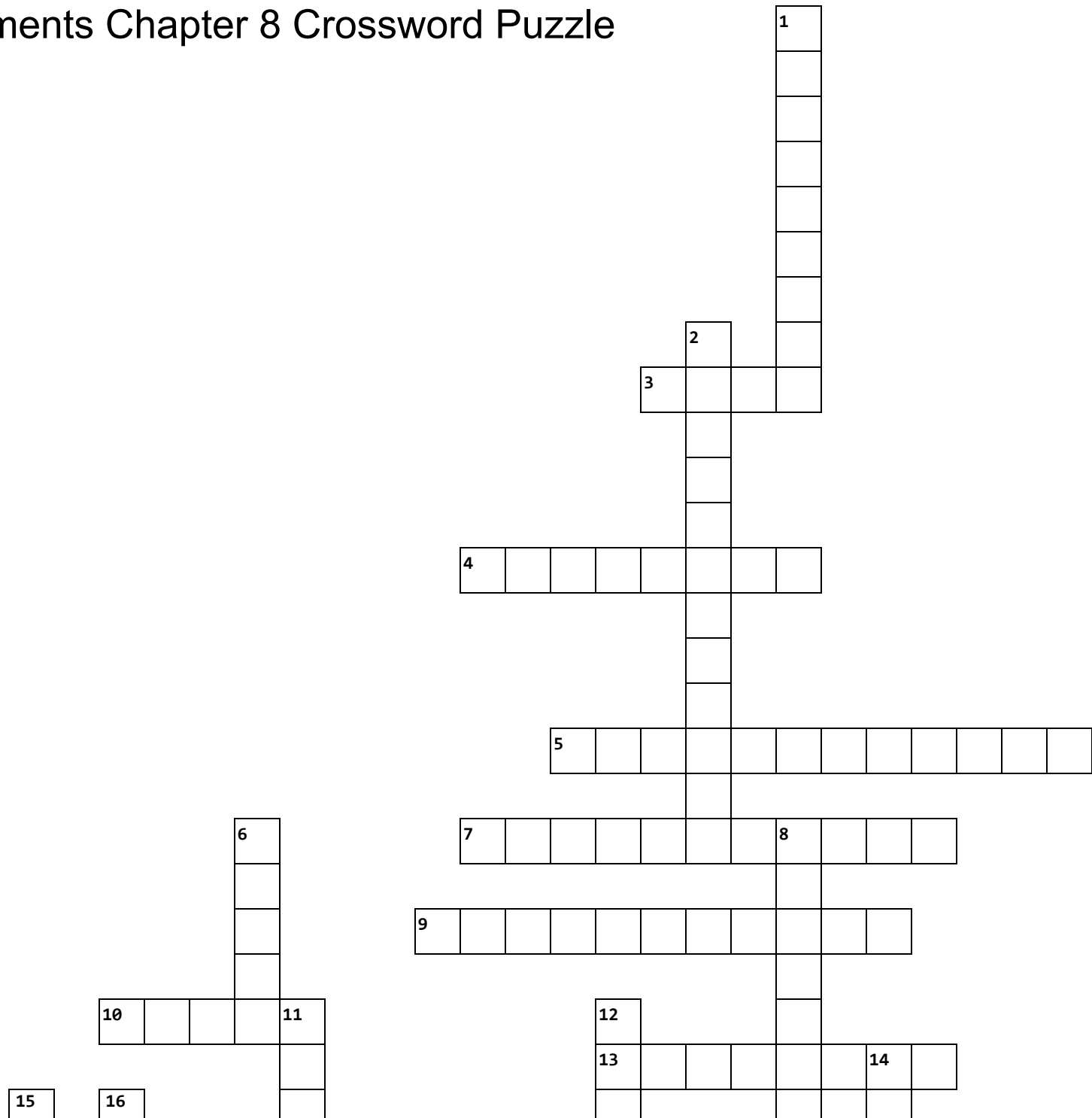
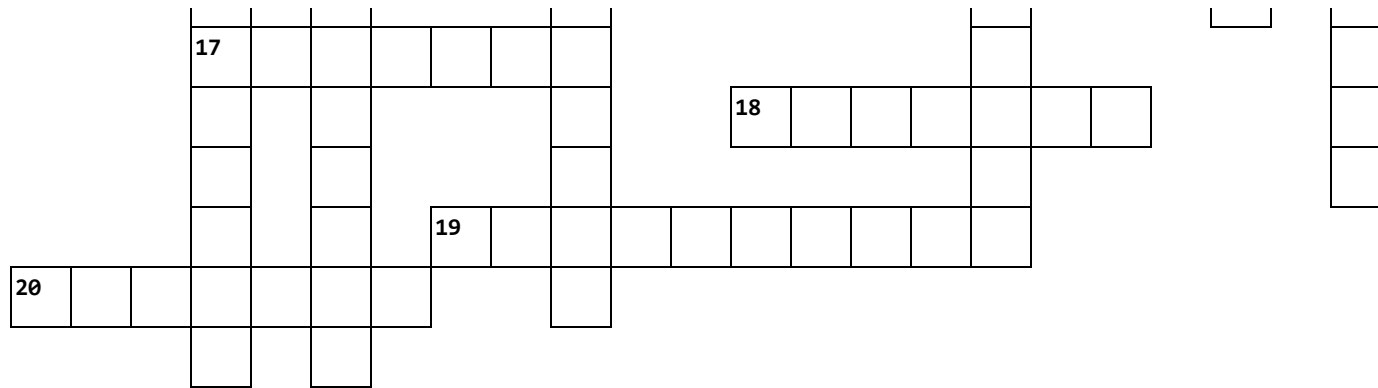


Seven Sacraments Chapter 8 Crossword Puzzle

- 4.** Comes from the Latin word "fides," meaning faithfulness
- 5.** Describes the permanent nature of the Sacrament of Matrimony
- 7.** Refers to God's choice to make his love visible in human flesh
- 9.** This dimension of marriage refers to one of the essential purposes of sex in marriage: fruitful love, understanding children as the supreme gift of marriage
