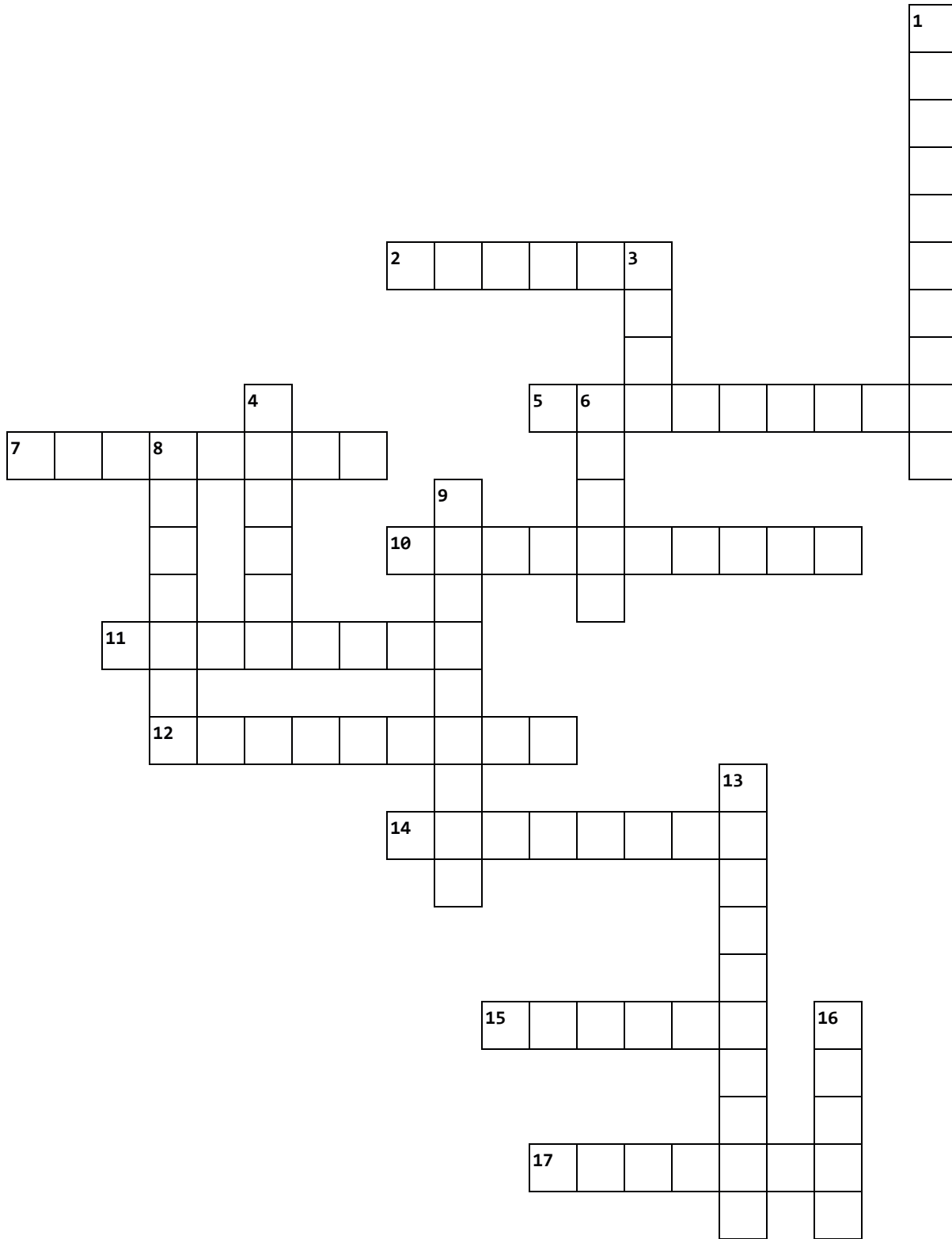


God Loves Crossword Puzzle Chapter 4
