

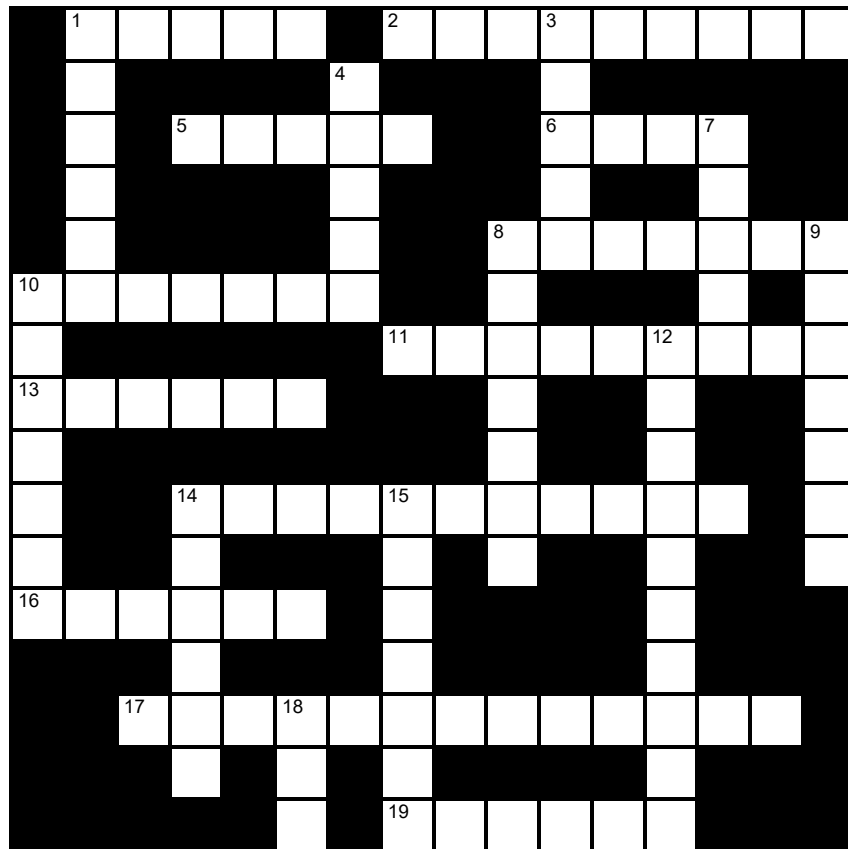
Chapter 10 The Old Testament Our Call to Faith and Justice

- 12 The translation of the Hebrew Scriptures into Greek (10)
- 14 A Roman general who separated the

civil and religious powers in Judea, appointing his own high priest in Jerusalem and setting up a puppet king (6)
