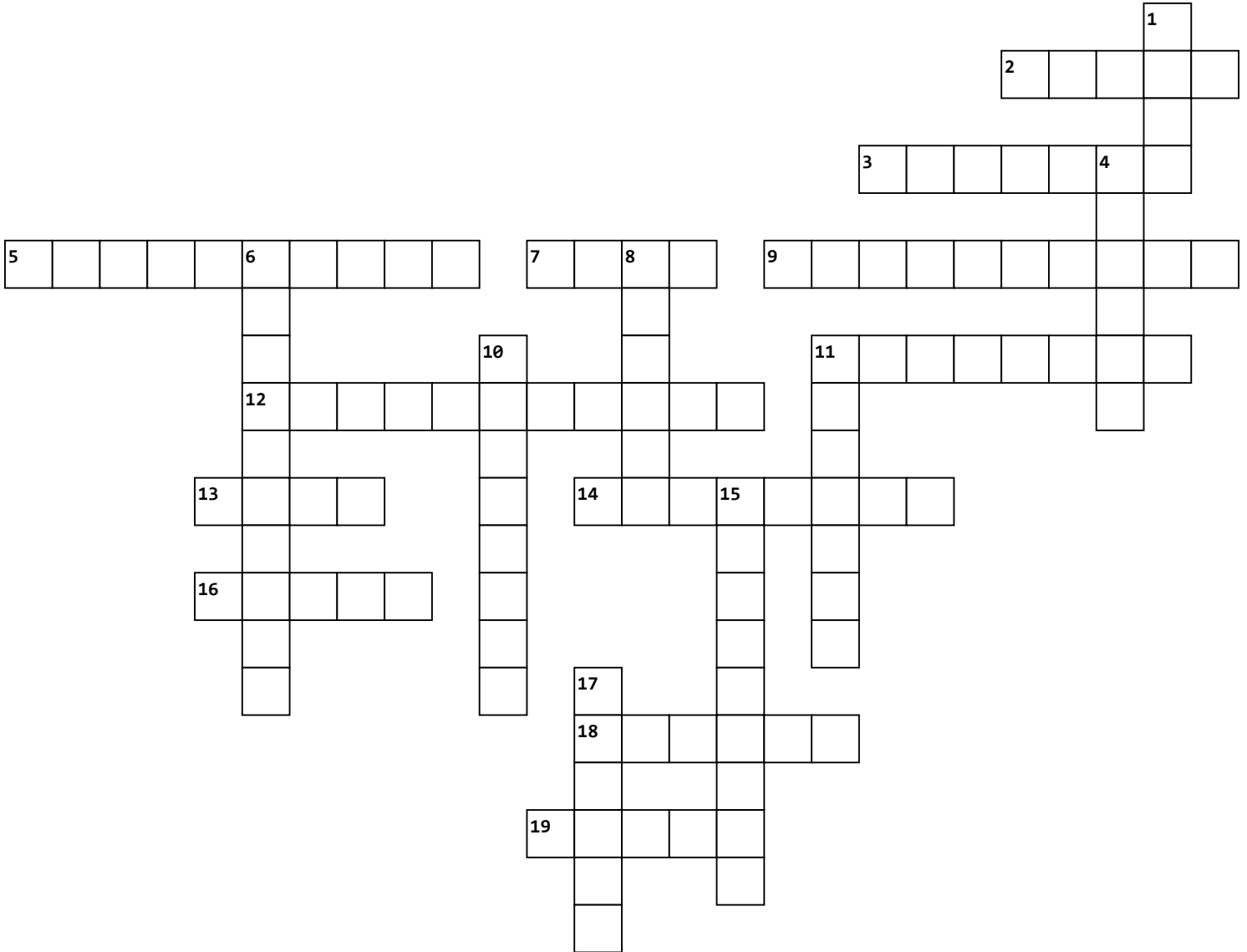


# God Loves Crossword Puzzle Chapter 2
