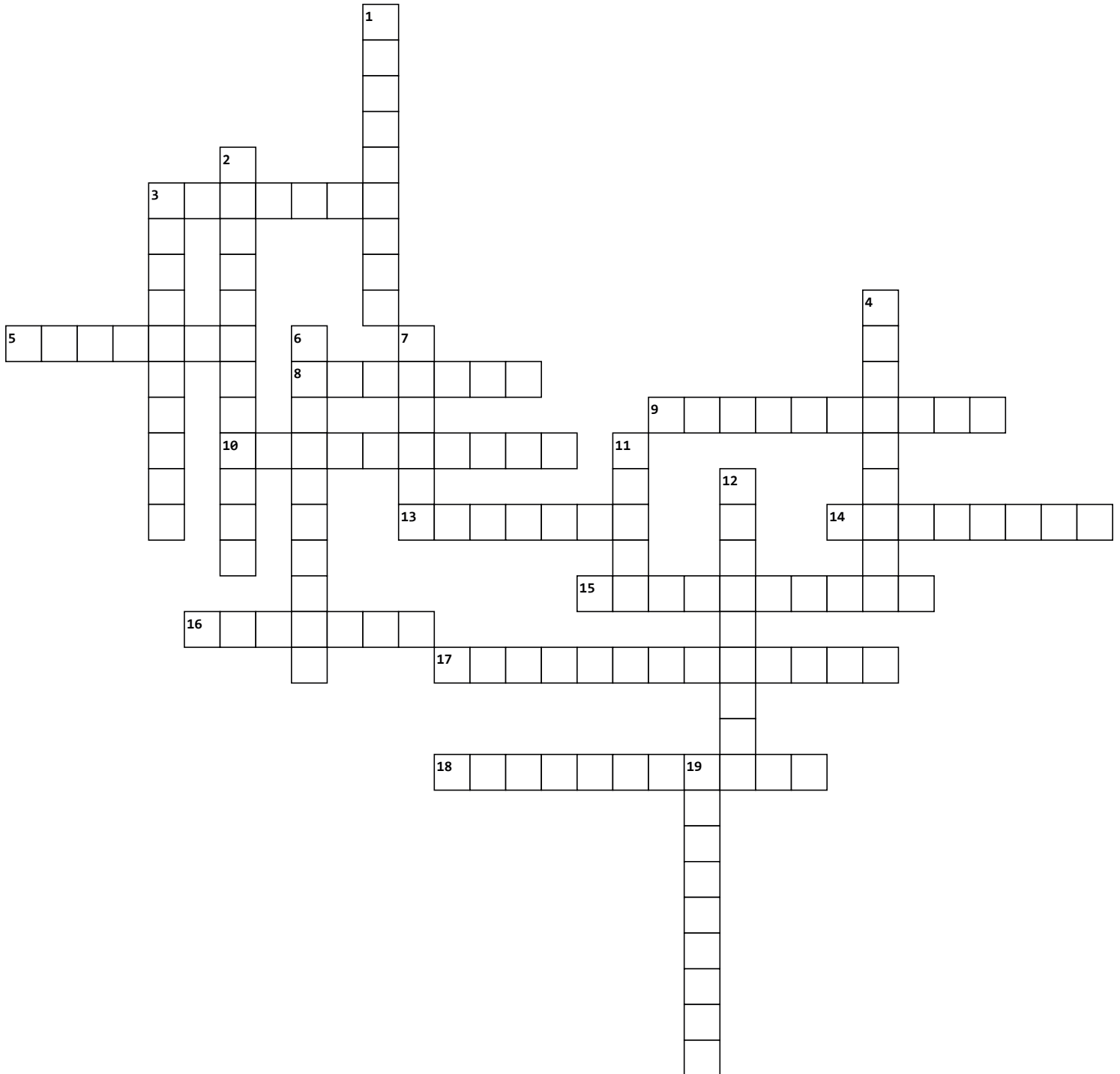


# God Saves Crossword Puzzle Chapter 7
