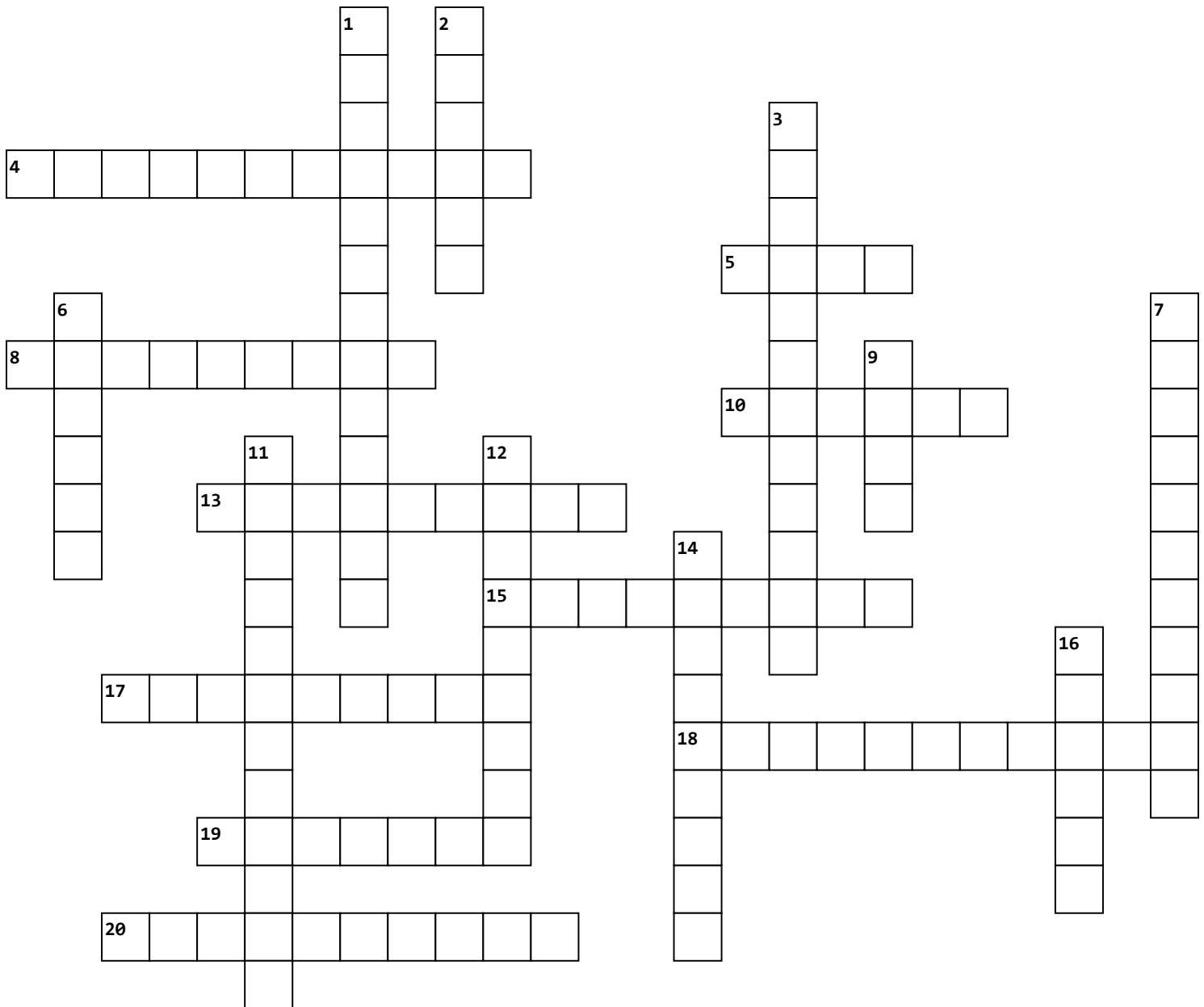


Holy Catholic Church Crossword Puzzle
